Title: Deep Trekker Launching Smaller, More Portable, Pipe Inspection Crawler

Abstract: Deep Trekker has built a reputation on providing contractors and municipalities with a robust, portable, and affordable pipe crawler system.

In 2018, Deep Trekker is set to launch its brand new pipe crawler which will carry the same features as the original DT340 Pipe Crawler which fits within a 200mm (8 inch) pipe - however, it will fit in a smaller 150mm (6 inch) pipe.

Built with rechargeable internal Lithium-Ion batteries which means there is no need for a dedicated service truck to transport the crawler.

Operated from the lightweight handheld controller, an operator is able to record live video data from within the pipe.

The 1KM tether option fits comfortably into one carrying case - allowing the unit to be deployed in the most remote locations.

Portability aside, the biggest differentiators of this Mini-Crawler are that it comes equipped with steerable wheels; allowing it to maneuver around obstacles, and that it is interchangeable with its bigger brother, the DT340. Using the same controller and tether, contractors and municipalities do not need to carry around multiple add-ons for their two robots.

And it's fully submersible.
