**Overview:** The management of buried infrastructure is a complex and costly endeavour, arguably the most challenging infrastructure public works professionals are tasked with making decisions on every day. Public Works professionals face difficult questions with respects to this infrastructure, including; What is the condition, How do I find out what condition it is in, How much resource should I put towards determining the condition? What options do I have once I know the condition? These questions are further complicated by the ever changing demands of increasing expectations and decreasing resources.

Many municipalities and utilities across Canada continue to struggle with these challenges while their infrastructure continues to age, lowering service levels and increasing risk of failure. So where does trenchless rehabilitation fit into the overall management of buried infrastructure? Can we afford not to utilize these technologies? How should they be viewed relative to traditional replacement? What is the best way to implement trenchless rehabilitation technologies? These are the types of questions all public works professionals should be asking.
